Funeral services for Lynn Harvey Commons 21, of Albany, who died this past week of injuries suffered while stationed aboard the tanker the USS Tombigee in the Philippines Islands, will be held Thursday at the E.U.B. Church at 2 P.M. Burial will be held at the Providence Cemetery. Rev. Alfred D. Enna of the First E.U.B. Church will officiate. The son of Erma S. and Harvey Commons, he was born November 2, 1943 in Albany where he raised and received his education. He graduated from Albany Union High School in 1961 and went into the Navy. He received his Basic Training at San Diego California and has been stationed aboard ship since that time. He has been in the service about 2-1/2 years. He had made his home with his parents Rt. #3, in the Riverside area of Albany prior to entering the service. He was a member of the First E.U.B. Church of Albany.

Besides his parents Mr. and Mrs. Harvey Commons of Albany he is survived by 3 (three) sisters, Mrs. Jim (Karen) Such of Albany, Mrs. Darrel (Pat Sample) of Gov. Camp Mt.
