Gary Lee Miller, 56, of Albany died Friday.

Born in Albany, Mr. Miller was the son of Earl W. Miller and the late Bette (Towery) Miller. He graduated from Albany High School in 1961.

He served in the Navy in the Vietnam War. After his discharge, he worked five years for the American Can Co. (Now Fort James Corp.). He worked on the Earl and Dennis Miller Farm and for the three years was employed by Lemons Millwork.

Mr. Miller enjoyed the outdoors and was a fisherman. He also enjoyed writing and was a member of the Street Masters Car Club of Albany. He was especially fond of his German shepherd, Barney, who was his constant companion.

Surviving are daughters Kelli Welch of Scio and Tamera Sidney of Wilton, Maine; father and stepmother Earl and Mildred Miller of Albany; brothers Dennis of Albany and Gail of Bend; and grandchildren Jamie and Cody Welch and Devin Sidney.

Besides mother Bette, granddaughter Jennifer Dawn died before him.
