Funeral service for Maynard Daniel Ropp, 27, Rt. 1 Box 403, who died Friday as a result of a helicopter accident near Quinaby Road NE, Salem, will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at Fairview Mennonite Church with Roy Hostetler and Verle Nofziger officiating.
